# Requirements for SUNY & SUNY Affiliated Residency Programs:

General requirements for participating in Residency Programs at or affiliated with SUNY:

\*OD degree from an Accreditation Council on Optometric Education accredited school or college of optometry

\*Su<mark>cc</mark>essful completion of Parts 1, 2, 3 with TMOD of the National Boa<mark>rd</mark> of Examiners in Optometry

\*Prospective residents on a F1 visa should apply for an OPT visa 90 days prior to date of graduation & provide proof of application

\*All residents affiliated with SUNY College of Optometry are required to be fully vaccinated for COVID, and once eligible, receive any booster or supplemental dose as required by the CDC, absent receipt of a medical exemption.

## SUNY salaried Programs & non VA/Military Affiliated Programs:

\*State Licensure (state where residency program is based) obtained prior to or by July 1 program start date
\*All persons appointed to the staff of the SUNY College of Optometry are required to provide, on the first day
of work, written documentation that they have authorization to work in the United States.

Combined Residency & Graduate Program: Must also meet Graduate Program requirements

#### Veteran Administration/Military Residency Programs:

- \*United States Citizen (unless it is a without compensation position at the Hudson Valley VA)
- \*Licensed Optometrist for Military based residency
- \*Licensure before completion (June 30) of the VA residency

ORMatch: All programs, except Womack, participate ORMatch. Applicants are encouraged to have completed boards, with results prior, to ORMatch.

### Requirements for Completion of Program:

- \* Meet advanced competencies as delineated by individual program

- \* Any program specific requirements, attendance, and satisfactory clinical and professional achievements

#### SUNY's "Friday Program": A Unique Feature of SUNY Residency

Unique to SUNY residency programs is the "Friday Program," or didactic program that includes various topical presentations, workshops and grand rounds. Residents from all programs, including affiliate and SUNY-salaried, participate in this program. These programs are usually scheduled on Fridays, but may be scheduled on other days of the week depending on lecture schedule and lecturers' availability. (The time for the educational component may overlap, but can be in addition to, the normal work week hours.)
