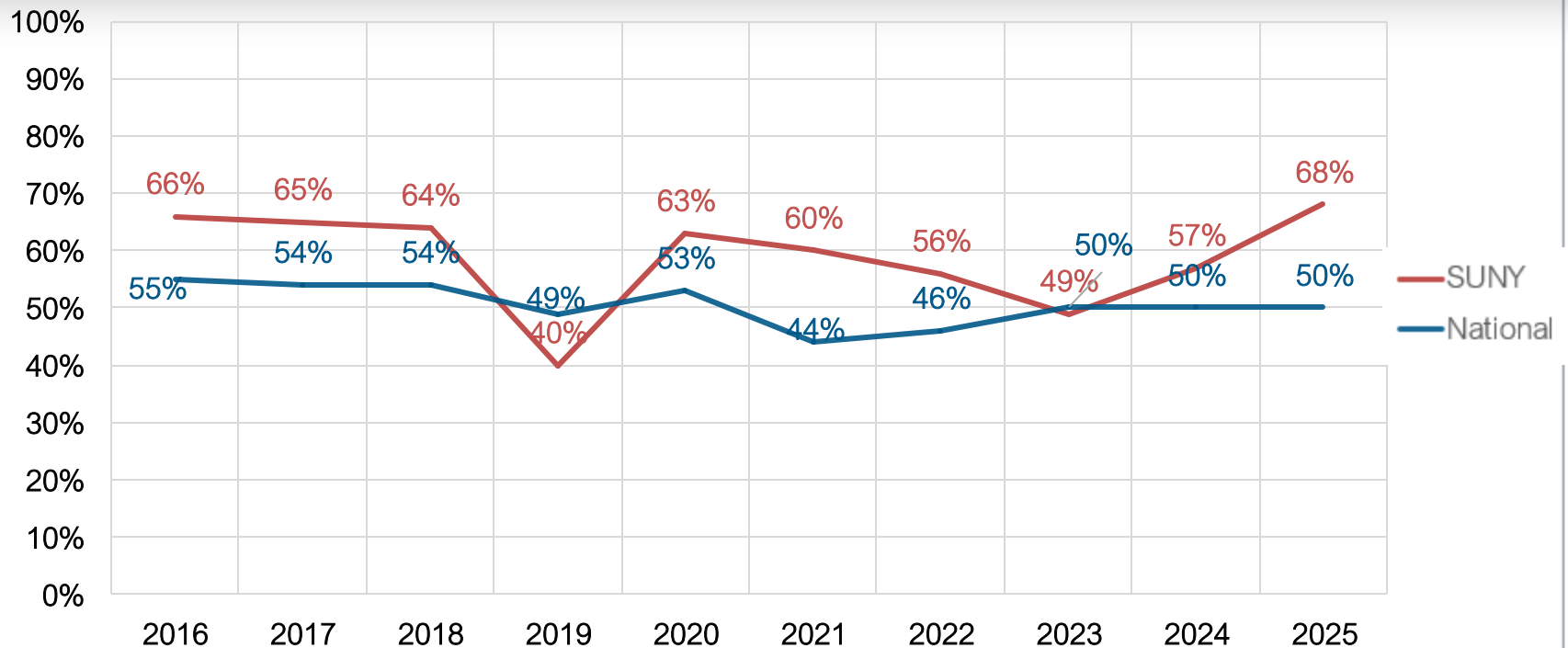


Yield by School per Year



This line chart shows yield by school per year from 2016 to 2025, comparing SUNY College of Optometry (red) to the national average (blue). National yield stays fairly steady, ranging from about 44% to 55%, dipping mid-period and leveling around 50% in later years. SUNY starts higher (around 64–66%), drops sharply to about 40% early on, then rises again with fluctuations, ending at its highest point near 68%. SUNY is above the national rate except for one year where it falls below.
